

such as cathedrals and fountains, Volvic lava stone convinces with its unfailing strength.


## Then, in its enamelled form, it became iconic.





# W I T H R E S P E C T F O R Q U A R R I E S

Lava is a real treasure. We protect it and the environment with sustainable quarrying.

## "NATURAL" EXTRACTION

No chemicals are used for extraction, which is carried out manually or mechanically. To avoid visual pollution, we restore each quarry as it is extracted.

## MONITORING NATURAL FAULTS

We study the faults present in the rock to optimize the blocks extracted.

## **LIMITING VOLUMES**

Responsible, reasoned extraction, with no more than 1,000 tonnes of rock extracted per year.

## THE "TRESSAILLAGE", THE DNA OF ENAMELLED LAVA


It appears when enamelled lava cools, in the form of a random pattern that makes each piece an exception.






