

Grand Hyatt Hong Kong

The Grand Café of Hong Kong's Grand Hyatt hotel, a local institution since its opening in the late 1980s, has been given a complete makeover by Melbourne design firm BAR Studio. Having undertaken numerous previous projects with BAR Studio, Pyrolave Australia was delighted to be selected to provide table tops for the innovative and dynamic redesign of the café-restaurant space, the overall concept of which was led by Stewart Robertson, Principal/Director of BAR Studio.

Detailed development of the project proceeded with BAR Studio designers, which resulted in specifying a range of tables top dimensions, some square, some circular, in Pyrolave's exquisitely vibrant gloss colours Ivoire and Tilleul – chosen to represent so effectively the historical and cultural associations for Hong Kong with bamboo.

Further planning was undertaken with two furniture manufacturers in Hong Kong to bring the conceptual designs for the table bases to fruition. The Pyrolave table tops, ranging from 750mm square and 25mm thick, up to 1400mm diameter and 30mm thick, all have simple bull-nose edgings.

These exquisite tables bring a subdued but elegant lustre to the Grand Cafés conceptual fusion of modern cuisine with classic Hong Kong market place.
